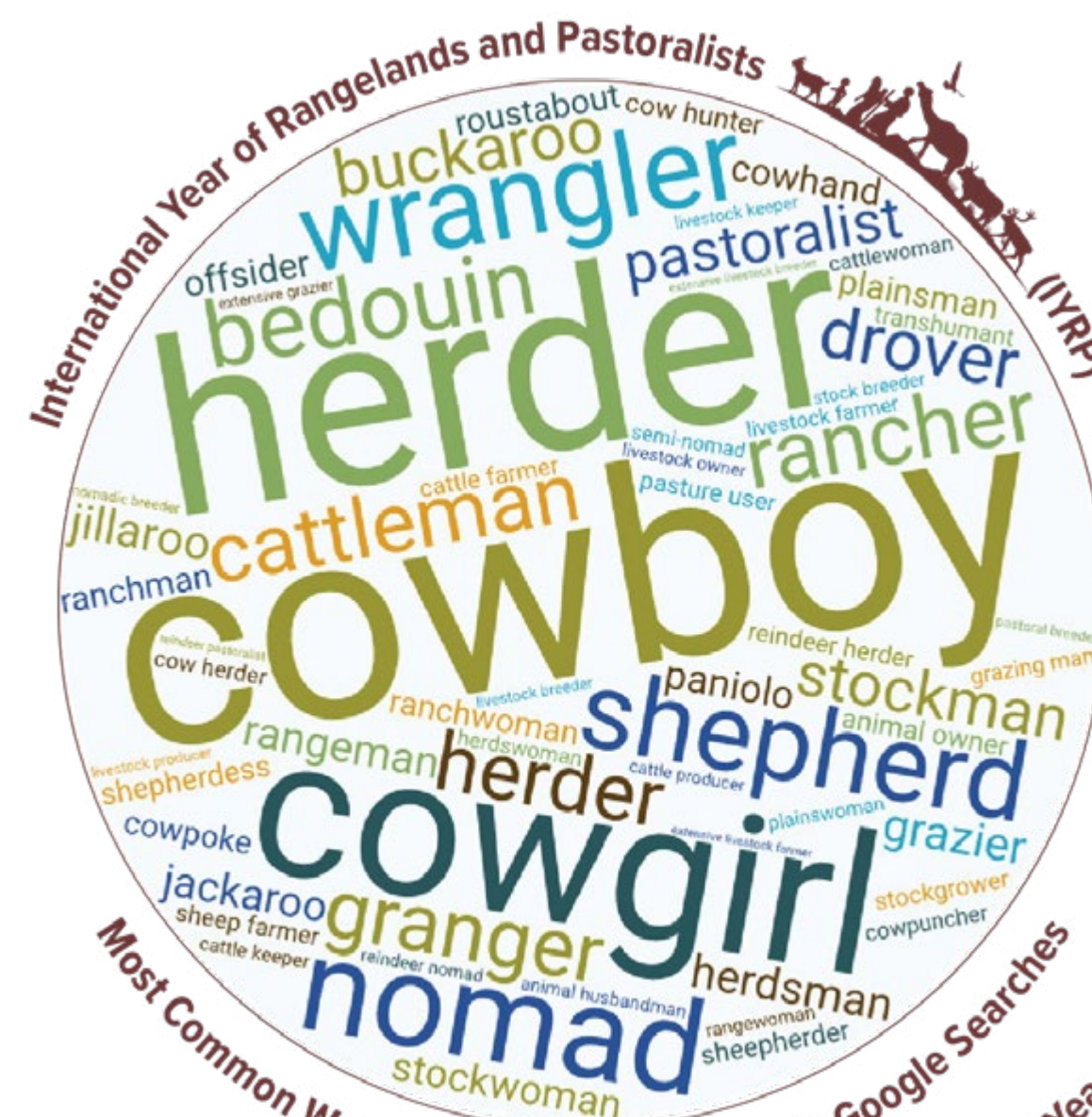
WHY AN IYRP?

GETTING TO SUSTAINABILITY

- **#IYRPFORSUSTAINABILITY** Rangelands directly support livelihoods of 500 million people and indirectly another 2 billion people along the entire value chain link to UNEP/IUCN Green Economy.
- **#IYRPFORHEALTH** Pastoral livestock products have high-value protein and are rich in nutrients due to a diverse forage intake link to Exec Summ IYRP UNFSS Parallel Session.
- **#IYRPFORHEALTH** Carbon sequestration can be significant in rangeland/pastoral system; pastoralism is not necessarily a net contributor to emissions www.pastres.org/livestock-report/.
- **#IYRPFORLIFE** Pastoralists adapt to and manage rangeland variability. Are livestock always bad for the Planet?
- **#IYRPFORNATURE** Rangelands are global biodiversity hotspots and habitat for numerous endangered species and offer valuable grazing land for both livestock & wildlife.
- **#IYRPFFORECONOMY** Rangelands cover at least 54% of earth's land surface – according to the most recent analysis www.rangelandsdata.org/atlas

The Mongolian Government proposal for an IYRP was endorsed by the FAO Conference in June 2021 and now moves to the General Assembly of the United Nations for a vote.
