### MERA GGPW, 2010

The Mera Global Gathering of Pastoralist Women 2010, organized in Gujarat, India, was a milestone conference that unstered more than 100 women pastoralists from 32 nations as representatives of their respective communities. Organized by MARAG and sponsored by international partners, the pioneering gathering created a much-needed platform for experience-sharing, networking, and generating global awareness of pastoralism's significance as a means of livelihood and land-use practice.

Women pastoralists, doubly marginalized, came together to raise their important leadership status, share concerns, and build empowerment. The meeting led to the powerful MERA Declaration, a 23-point charter of demands calling for recognition, equal representation, and policy reform. The meeting galvanized a campaign for the rights of pastoralist women, unity, and continuous action at regional and global levels.

- 2. Updating MERA Declaration reflecting the current challenges, climate, and environmental context
- 3. Selecting a few women representatives to convey key messages from the Mera+15 gathering to policymakers worldwide during 2026, in both the IYRP and the IYWF arenas.
- 4. Promoting a solid network of networks and organizations working on women pastoralist issues for continued policy advocacy and campaign beyond IYRP
